TO TRANSFER

A student must:

- x Complete 60 semester/90 guarter C& ansferable units including a minimum of 30 semester/45 guarter units in general education courses with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- x Complete Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 with a grade out for the provided of the p
- Be in good standing at the last college or university attended, and have completed or made up any missing college preparatory subject requirements.

Prior totransfer, it is strongly recommended that students complete the CSU GE pattern in full including the American Institution graduation requirement. Certain programs have more applicants than there are spaces available. These "impacted programs" have additional screening requirements. Please see an SMC counselor or wisismc.edu/articulatior for details.

It is the student's responsibility to request certification. Petitions for certification may be filed in the Admissioneshoffi January 1 through July 31 for the Spring semester, and Octotheough December 1 for students planning to complete requirements during the Fall semester.

Certification petitions are available on those dates in the Admissions Office and online (go to www.smcedu/admissions/forms.htm Request for certification will be processed ONLY during those periods.

Applications to the CSU are available onlinevatw.csumentor.edu Applications to impacted programs must be filed during t priority-filing period, which is the first month applications are accepted for a given term. Many campuses are approaching capacity in a number of academic disciplines and are likely to dospedications after the first month of the filing period. Campuses, which are less impacted, racgept applications up to one month prior to the opening day of the term, though individual programs may close earlier.
