In accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), Project IMPACT will not disclose any student information without a signed release of records on file with our program specifically.

Additionally, when a release of records is signed, we like to clarify how we will communicate regarding student information. Project IMPACT is committed to fostering student independence and self-advocacy. With this goal in mind, the program has very specific guidelines regarding parental/guardian communication and involvement.

Communication is primarily between staff members and student participants. Encourage your child to talk with us directly. Exceptions are made in emergency situations only including academic, personal, and safety crises.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) may share any information they like directly
